We had lots of fun and winners last year, and this year we will be adding a very special *Bill Boyd Memorial Choice Award!* This special ribbon will be awarded along with the others and we hope this will add to the challenge and enjoyment of the competition for exhibitors, collectors and all Jubilee guests.

Please submit your bears and other friends in the categories below.

Competition Guidelines are on the back.

In-the-Fur 6" and smaller

Dressed/Costumed 6" and smaller

In-the-Fur over 6" up to and including 14"

Dressed/Costumed over 6" up to and including 14"

In-the-Fur over 14"

Dressed/Costumed over 14"

Artistic Esthetics Vignettes, collaborations, groupings; all sizes, in-the-fur, dressed or costumed!



GUIDELINES

- All critters welcomed!
- Measurements are considered from the top of head to the bottom of foot. For those on all fours, measure from tip of nose to tip of tail and from top of head to bottom of foot. The larger measurement determines entry category.
- In-the-Fur creatures may be trimmed with simple bow, collar, or hat. Wings or any other accessory that encompasses 1/3 or more of the animals body shall be considered Dressed/Costumed.
- *Artistic Esthetics* are those embellished creations that won't fit in any other category! This includes vignettes, collaborations, a group of animals that tell a story, a single animal with a chest of treasures, etc. They may be dressed/costumed or not. The size of the animals is not a consideration in the judging, however because of the space factor, please keep these displays limited to 14 square inches.
- Please furnish stands for any pieces that are designed to be displayed as standing.
- All entries will be judged for Best of Show and Chainbear's Award
- Your sales come first! If a patron shows interest in a competition piece, they and your piece will be escorted to your table for completion of your sale transaction. If the item is not sold, it can be returned to competition.

Because we do have space constraints, each category will be limited to 10 entries. Entries may be submitted during Saturday morning set-up, between 7:15 and 8:45 a.m. on a first received/first accepted basis. NO tags or other means of artist identification should be on your entry piece.

- Exhibitors and Conventioneers will receive ballots in their registration packets. The general public will receive ballots with paid admission. Voting will take place between 9 a.m. and 1 p.m.
- Winners will be announced and winning entries will receive beautiful custom made rosette ribbons at 2 p.m. The display will remain in tact for photography until 3 p.m.
- Entries may be claimed at 3 p.m. Be sure to have your entry receipt to claim your creation.
- The Jubilee Committee will rule in all disputes. The Committee's decision is final.
